TEMANDROTA | BIOGRAPHY Oct 2024

ABOUT

Temandrota (his official name is Randriahasandrata Razafimandimby) is a painter and sculptor based in Antananarivo, Madagascar's capital city. Born in 1975, he attended Antananarivo University, after which, in the absence of any Fine Art School in the entire country, he resolved to teach himself, attending a great number of Art Residencies at home and abroad.

His work includes painting, installations, performance and sculpture. He draws inspiration from the indigenous Tandroy people who live in the Southeast of Madagascar—of whom he is a descendant. Mixing materials that are traditionally used by that community such as sisal, earth, roots, sap, and cane, with acrylic and spray paint, he often adds bits of recycled objects. The production of the works involves protocols the artist sets himself that incorporate intangible aspects of the Tandroy culture: preliminary trips to gather his materials, meditation practices, dance and music.

Temandrota's paintings are on a base of paper that he makes himself and reinforces with natural fibers. Earth is always the prime material, which he mixes alchemically with others, using fire heat to get the consistency and color he wants. He alternates working gesturally, at times through a particular dance, and carefully applies collages, layering materials and patterns. Recalling aspects of Art Brut, or Arte Povera, his paintings are unique in so far as they distil, from an insider's perspective, interconnections between indigenous cosmogonies with the most recent concerns in soil science, the "Third revolution" of the technological age, climate change, and societal struggles.

Temandrota was the first recipient of the "Paritana Prize" developed by the *Foundation H*, Antananarivo in 2017. Beyond multiple artistic interventions in the communities around the country, he had a series of solo shows in Madagascar including at the *Hakanto Foundation*. He was Resident at the prestigious *Cite des Arts* in Paris twice, where he had a noted solo show at *Fondation H*, and where he

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showed at the Musee des Arts Premiers. Other residencies abroad include The William Kentridge Art Centre, and the Greatmore Studios, in South Africa.
